I, Charles Homer Rose, III, being of the age of 36 years, hereby apply for membership in this Society by right of blood descent in the following line from Jesse Rose, I who was born in Berkeley Co., Va. on the day of July 1760 and died in Rosemont, Ohio on the day of July 1852 and who assisted in establishing American Independence. I was born in Plainfield, N.J. County of Union State of New Jersey on the 13 day of February 1944

and he, the said Jesse Rose I (No. 6) is the ancestor who assisted in establishing American Independence, while acting in the capacity of Private in Third Virginia Regiment

Applicant affirms his adherence to the principles set forth in the Declaration of Independence and his unshaken support of the Constitution of the United States of America, to the end that the inalienable rights of the citizen may be preserved and our ideal representative government perpetuated.

ANCESTOR'S SERVICE

Section 1. Any man shall be eligible to membership in this Society who, being at the age of eighteen years or over, and a citizen of good repute in the community, is the lineal descendant of an ancestor who was at all times unflinching in his loyalty to, and rendered active service in, the cause of American Independence, either as an officer, soldier, seaman, militia-man or minute man, in the armed forces of the Continental Congress or of any one of the several Colonies or States, or as a signer of the Declaration of Independence; or as a member of a Committee of Safety or Correspondence; or as a member of any Continental, Provincial, or Colonial Congress or Legislature; or as a recognized patriot who performed actual service by acts of resistance to the authority of Great Britain.

Membership is based upon one original claim; when the applicant derives eligibility by descent from more than one Revolutionary ancestor, and it is desired to file additional claims, separate applications on special forms provided for the purpose, should be made in each case and filed with the original.

State fully each documentary or traditional authority as you found the following record upon, and also the residence of ancestor, with dates of birth and death, if known.

By order of the Board of Trustees, May 3, 1911, the recipient of a certificate granted on this application agrees to surrender his certificate upon failure to pay his membership dues, unless his membership shall cease by reason of death or actual disability, to be determined by the Society of which he is a member.

My ancestor's services in assisting in the establishment of American Independence during the War of the Revolution were as follows: Private in the Third Virginia Regiment, drafted in August or Sept. 1781, Berkeley Co., Va. for a tour of 6 months. Was at the capture of Lord Cornwallis on 19 October, 1781. Pension request rejected as he did not serve the necessary time required by law.
