Stroke of Paralysis.**

Mr. A. A. Cathey died about 9 o'clock last night at his home in Paw Creek as the result of a stroke of paralysis received in Charlotte yesterday afternoon on West Trade street. He was 69 years of age and was a well-known citizen of the county, serving as coroner for 18 years. He was a brave soldier in Company G, Thirty-fourth Regiment and lost a leg at Gettysburg. He leaves a wife and five children, Mrs. H. J. Cathey, Rev. S. L. Cathey, Neal, Luther and John Cathey.

The funeral will be held at Paw Creek to-morrow at noon.
