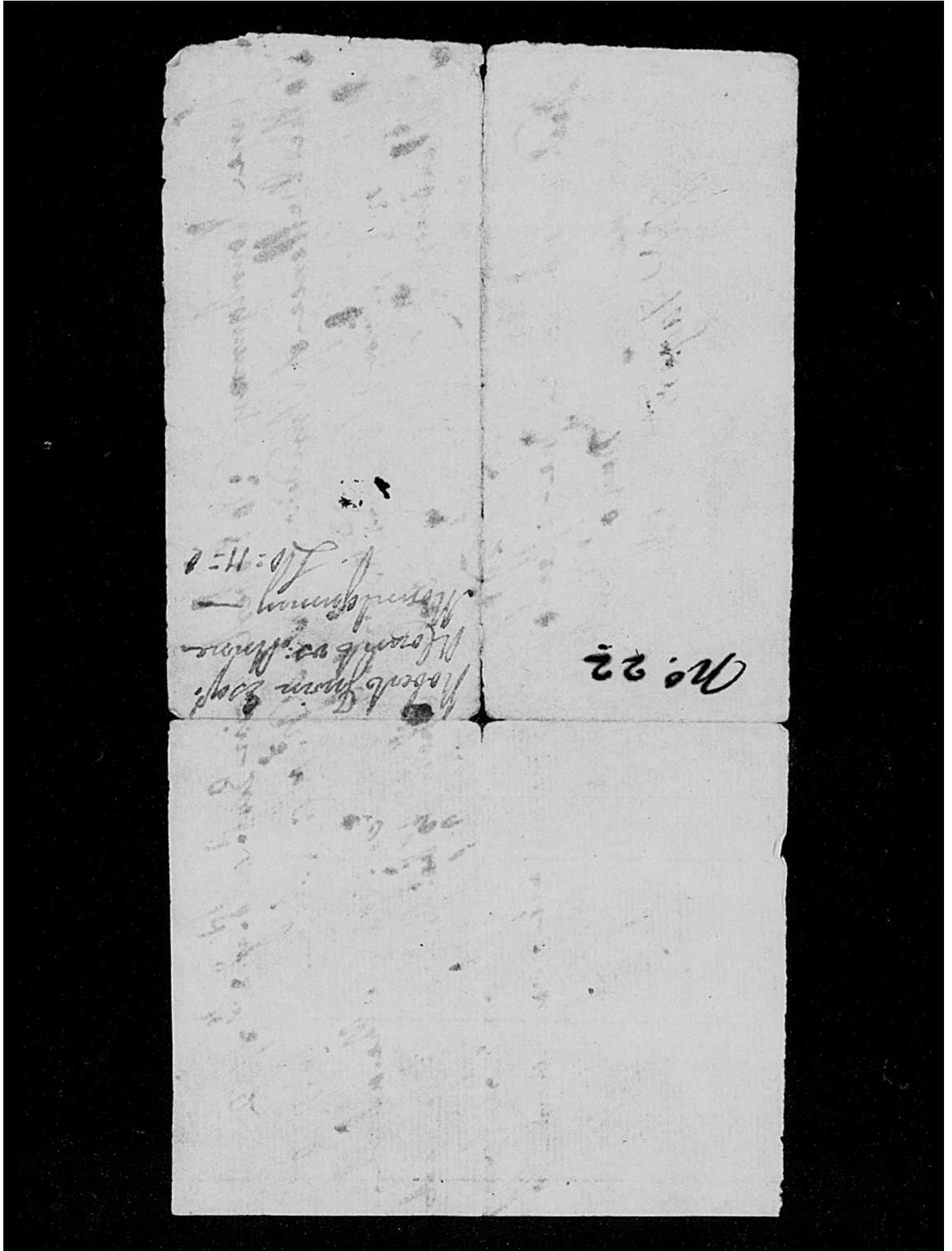

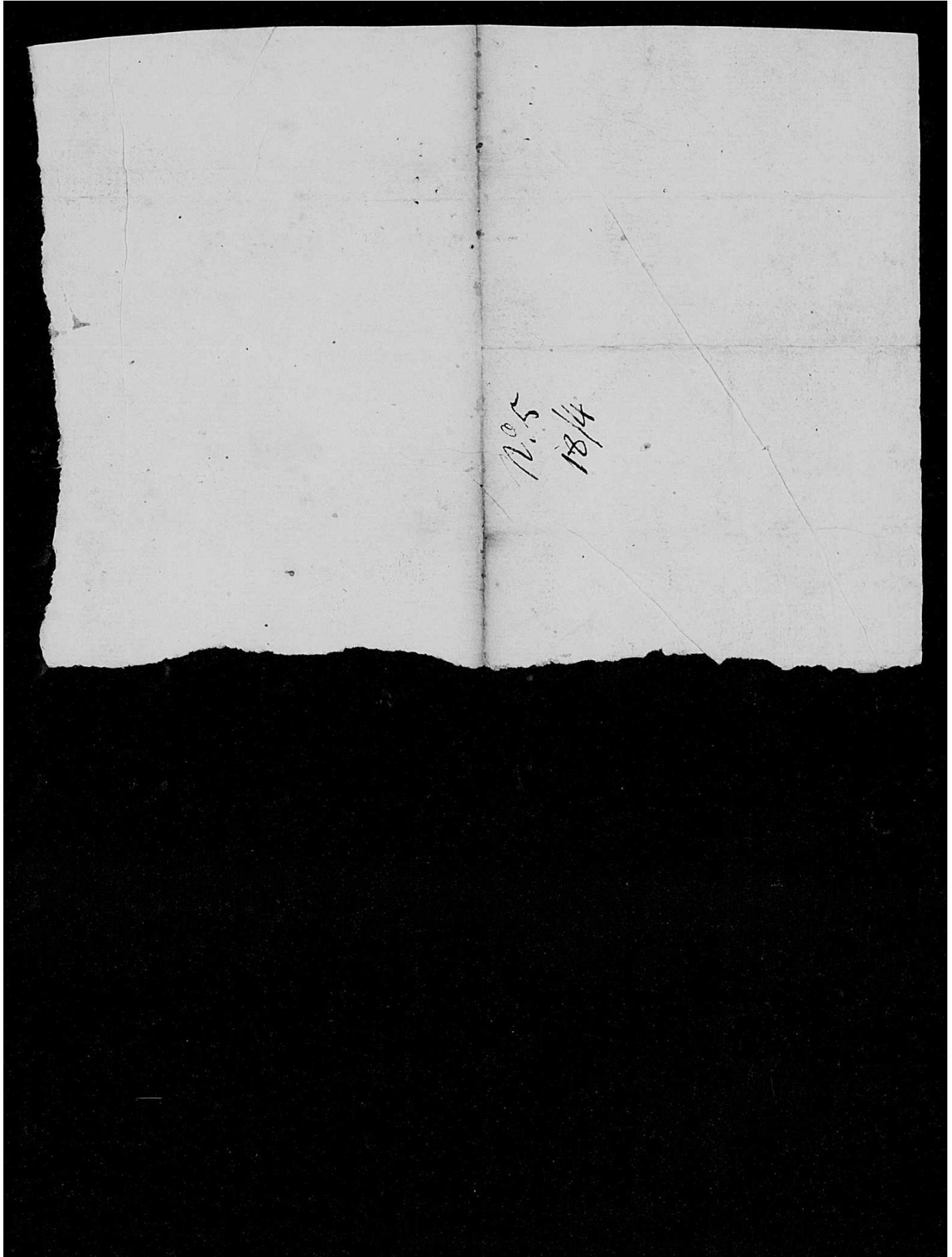

 County Court of Mecklenburg in the penal sum of Two Thousand
 pounds Current Money, to be paid to the said
 Chairman or his successors in Office - To the which
 payment well & truly, to be made we bind ourselves our Heirs Execu^{rs}
 Administrators, jointly & severally firmly, by these presents - Sealed
 with our Seals & Dated this 27th Day of October AD 1793

The Condition of the above Obligation is such
 that the above bound Administrators
 of all & singular the goods & chattels, rights & credits of
 Deceased do make or cause to be made a true
 & perfect Inventory of all & singular the goods & chattels, rights & credits
 of the Deceased which have or shall come to the hands, knowledge or
 possession of the said
 or unto the hands or possession of any person or persons for them And
 the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Clerks
 Office where orders of Administration passed within ninety days after
 the date of these presents; & the same goods, chattels & credits of all
 other goods chattels & credits of the deceased at the time of his
 death, which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or posses-
 sion of the said
 or into the hands
 or possession of any other person or persons for them do well & truly ad-
 minister according to Law, & further do make or cause to be made a
 true & just account of their said Administration within ninety days
 after the date of these presents of all the rest & residue of the said
 goods chattels & credits which shall be found remaining upon the said
 Administrators account (the same being first examined by the Court)
 shall deliver & pay unto such person or persons respectively as the
 same shall become due pursuant to the true intent & meaning
 of the Act in that case made & provided - And if it shall appear
 that

That any Will or Testament was made by the Deceased of the
 Executor or Executors therein named do exhibit the same
 into Court making request to have it allowed & approved of accord-
 ingly if the said
 Above Bound being therein required do render & deliver the
 said Letter or Administration (approbation of such Testament
 being first had & made in the said Court) then this Obligation
 to be Void, otherwise to remain in full force & Virtue —

was made — *Ordered therefore that Joseph*
Byham & John Montgomery *Admin: on all &*
singular the Goods & Chattels rights & Credits
of the said Ann Montgomery the having
Complied with the Law in that case required

THESE are therefore to empower the said *Joseph Byham*
John Montgomery to enter into and upon all and singular the goods
and chattels, rights and credits of the deceased, and the same into *their* possession take,
wherefoever in this state to be found, and an inventory thereof, on oath, to return into
Clerks office, within ninety days from the date hereof: and all the just debts of the
deceased to pay, so far as the said estate will extend or amount to.
